Step 1 – Installing Fixed Posts

- **1.1** Insert the top post into the bottom post and secure with M6 x 65 bolts, nuts and washers.
- **1.2** Mark out the desired position for the post in line with the Retracting Clothesline Cabinet.
- **1.3** Refer to your Retracting Clothesline product manual for site selection and installation details.
- 1.4 Dig a hole 200mm (8") in diameter x 800mm (32") deep. Place approximately 200mm (8") of coarse gravel in the bottom of the hole.
- **1.5** Insert the post into the ground.
- **1.6** Adjust the post until the desired height is achieved (refer to your Retracting Clothesline product manual).
- **1.7** Support the post and concrete into position.
- **1.8** Concrete should be damp enough to hold together when squeezed in your hand.
- **1.9** Settle the concrete by pushing a thin stick into the mix several times.
- **1.10** Use a spirit level to check the assembly is vertical.
- **1.11** Slope the surface of the concrete away from the post to provide drainage.

Allow 48 hours for the concrete to set before use.

If a socket is used, do not remove the post until the concrete has set.

Note: When assembling your cabinet to your post, all fasteners required are supplied with your mount bar.

Height Adjustment

- 2.1 Your Post Kit has three height positions for a total of 236mm (9 5/16") adjustment (**Fig. 1**).
- **2.2** To adjust the height of the top post, remove bolts, washers and nuts and move to new position.
- 2.3 Re-secure bolts, washers and nuts.
- **2.4** For smaller incremental line height adjustment, cut the required amount from the bottom of the post.
