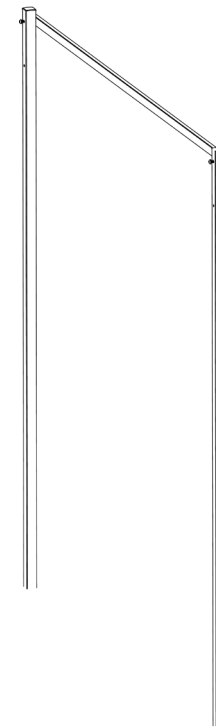

- Do not use for any purpose other than to hang and dry washing.
- Do not use your clothesline if parts are worn or damaged.
- Do not allow the frame to lower in an uncontrolled manner as damage or injury may result.

In addition to all rights and remedies to which you may be entitled under the New Zealand Consumer Guarantees Act (1993) and any other relevant legislation, Soudal NZ Limited warrants the product to be free from defects in materials or workmanship for 10 years from the date of purchase.

In the event of a claim, you must take the product with proof of purchase and an explanation of the fault to the place of purchase or contact Soudal NZ Limited and provide your proof of purchase. All costs associated with the return of the good (and other expenses incurred in claiming under this warranty) are your responsibility. We will, at our option, either repair or replace the product if it has a defect in its materials or workmanship.

Soudal NZ Limited liability under this warranty is subject to Soudal NZ Limited being satisfied that a defect was caused by defective workmanship or materials and was not caused by or substantially contributed to by other factors including (but not limited to) maintenance or repair, adjustments or modifications of the product in a manner not recommended by the manufacturers or any neglect, misuse or excessive use. 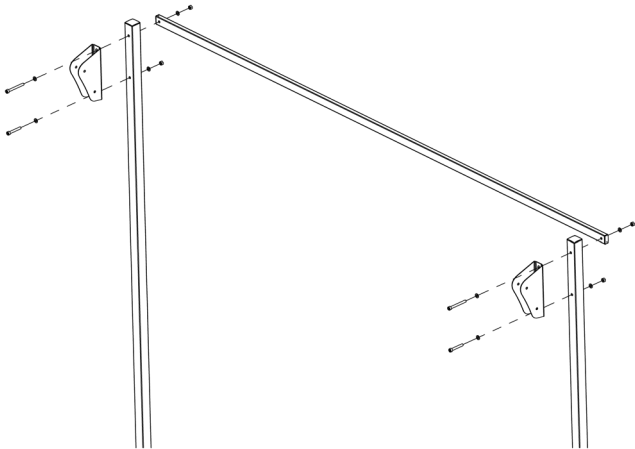

- 2.5 Mix the concrete and fill the holes around the posts.
- 2.6 Using a spirit level, check that the posts are parallel with each other and level.
Adjust accordingly.
- 2.7 Pack the concrete firmly around the posts, and settle by poking with a thin stick.
- 2.8 Slope the surface of the concrete away from the posts to assist with drainage.

Allow 48 hours for the concrete to set.

Step 3 – Attaching the clothesline

- 3.1 After allowing 48 hours for the concrete to set, remove the cross brace and fasteners.
- 3.2 Attach the clothesline brackets on to the post kit. The M8 x 75 bolts are for the upper holes. The M8 x 55 bolts are for the lower holes.



Once you have installed the brackets on to your post kit, please refer to your Folding Clothesline instruction manual for all steps required for assembly and installation.

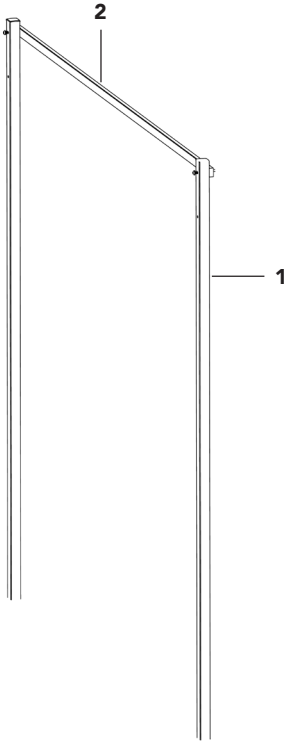

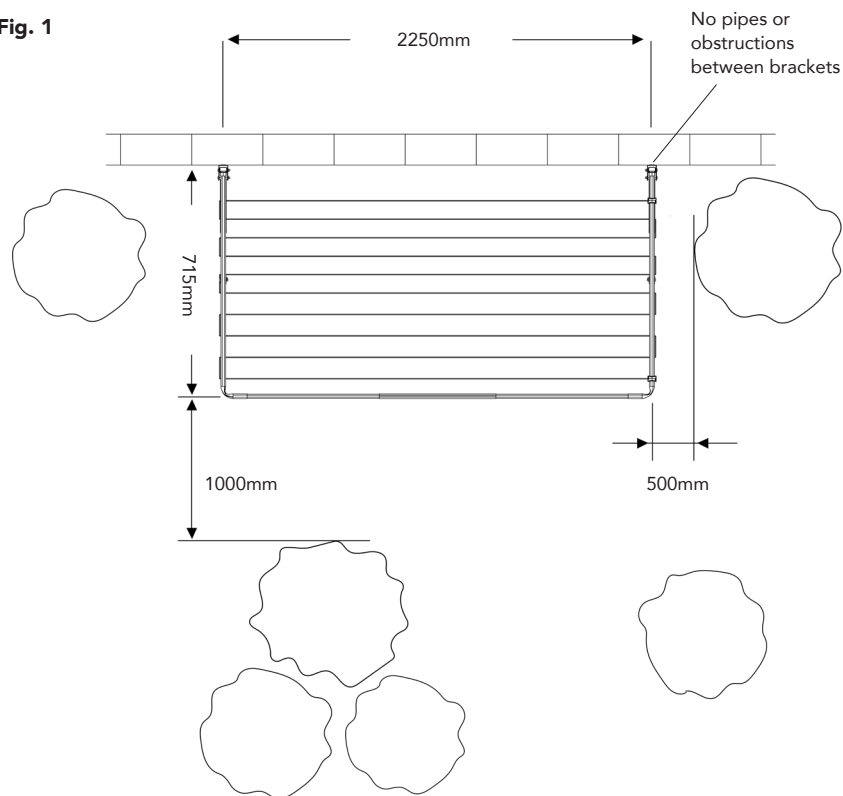


Installation

Step 1 – Select a suitable location

- 1.1** You must check to ensure you have sufficient space in your backyard to install your clothesline (Fig. 1).

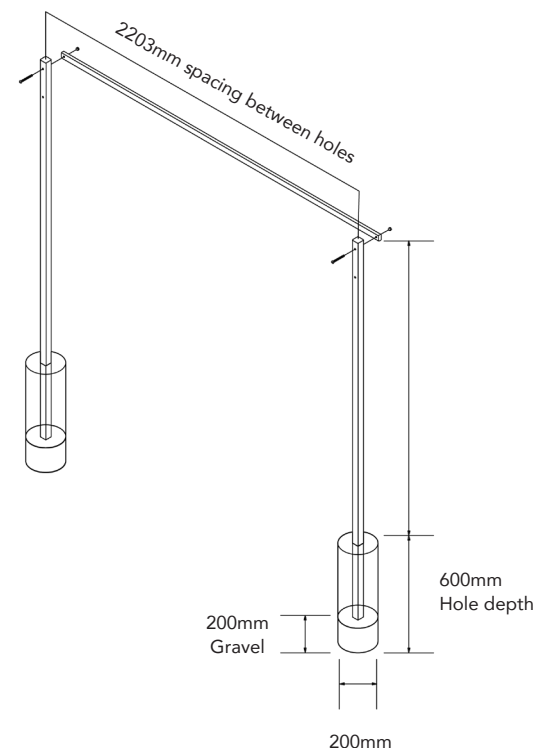
- 1.2** We recommend mounting your Folding Clothesline at a height approximately 50mm (2") above the head height of the intended user.

Note: Please refer to the applicable Sun King Folding Clothesline instruction manual for further information about assembly, installation, and operation of the product.

Step 2 – Installing directly into a concrete pad

Note: Accessory pack may be supplied in post tube. Remove end cap for access.

- 2.1** With a suitable location selected, mark 2x centre marks spaced at 2203mm apart for the post hole locations
- 2.2** Dig two holes 200mm diameter x 600mm deep. Add approximately 200mm of gravel to the bottom of the hole for drainage.



- 2.3** Place the posts into the holes and support each post vertically. Add or remove gravel until the top bolt hole is 50mm above the head of the intended user.
- 2.4** Loosely attach the cross brace to the top holes in each post using 2x M8 x 75 bolts and 2x M8 Nuts. This will help maintain alignment and will be removed once concrete has set.
